CHILD PROTECTION POLICY

Westfield & District Cricket & Sports Club fully accepts its legal and moral obligation to exercise its duty of care to protect all children and vulnerable adults participating in its activities, and to safeguard their welfare.

We are committed to do this by acknowledging that:

1. The welfare of the child and vulnerable adult is paramount.
2. Each vulnerable adult and child irrespective of age, gender, religion, race or disability has the right to protection from abuse.
3. Each child and vulnerable adult has a right to be safe, and to be protected with respect and dignity.

We shall use our best endeavours to ensure that:

1. All allegations of abuse are taken seriously.
2. The response to them is swift and appropriate
3. The effectiveness of our policy is reviewed annually.
4. A responsible person or persons shall be appointed annually as a Welfare Officer to whom members can address any concerns.
5. To help, encourage and support other affiliated clubs in the introduction and maintenance of child protection.
